



## Online store's requirements for Edenred online payments:

### **The partner must ensure that the product / service is purchased for own use.**

- ▶ The easiest way is to require the customer to create a user account before making a payment. It is recommended to confirm the user account, for example, via a link sent to an e-mail.
- ▶ Another way is to ask the customer to choose whether to buy the product / service for themselves or as a gift. In case when selecting "for yourself", the product / service can only be sent to the subscriber. When ordering for yourself, for example, the name of the buyer, i.e. the user, must be entered in the event ticket.
- ▶ For lunch purchases, the Tax Administration has set a limit that only one product / service can be purchased during one purchase transaction. The online store must ensure that it is not possible to buy several products / services, i.e. group orders, in the same purchase. For lunch purchases, the Tax Administration's payment limits also limit the size of the purchases (see next section).

### **The partner must consider the annual payment limits set by the Tax Administration for lunch purchases.**

- ▶ The Tax Administration publishes annual minimum and maximum amounts for lunch purchases. They also apply to online shopping. The amount should only include the cost of the meal, it cannot include, for example, a transport fee or a meal for two. In exceptional cases, the Tax Administration may change the instructions, in which case up-to-date information can be found on the Tax Administration's website.
- ▶ If the e-commerce purchase transactions are most often more than the maximum amount set by the Tax Administration, the partner must decide the possible splitting of the payment himself. If a payment is attempted for an amount greater than the upper limit set by the Tax Administration, the payment will be declined.
- ▶ However, if the amount of the online store purchase is less than the minimum amount set by the Tax Administration, the customer's card will be charged a minimum amount.

### **The partner must ensure that it is not possible to purchase products / services that are not covered by the tax benefit in the online store with Edenred's online payment.**

- ▶ If there are products / services in the online store that are not taxable benefits, their purchase must be prevented with an Edenred online payment. In practice, this can be done, for example, at the payment stage, when the e-commerce platform checks whether there are prohibited products / services in the shopping cart. Such are e.g. sports equipment.
- ▶ Purchases of unauthorized products / services can be restricted using the BIN range. The BIN range identifies both the card issuer and the card type, i.e. it tells the online store that payment is now made with an Edenred card. In this case, the online store checks the BIN of the entered payment card and which products / services of the online store can be paid with the card with the BIN range. If there are unauthorized products / services in the shopping cart, payment cannot be made. Edenred's BIN starts with the numbers 534287, which means that product definitions can be made according to the payment method starting with those numbers.

**Please note that the partner is responsible for ensuring that the online store complies with the Tax Administration's specifications!**

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
